The Climb for Cancer Foundation, a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization, helps ease the pain and suffering of those affected by cancer. The Foundation funds psycho-social programs which provide support to the patient and their families, sponsors research grants, and gives

children with cancer opportunities to attend summer and sports camps. Some of the projects we support include:

HARRIET'S HELPING HAND FAMILY SUPPORT PROGRAM assists cancer patients and their families with Parking, On-Campus Dining and Fuel Vouchers while they are undergoing cancer therapy at the University of Florida and Shands Cancer Center.

LIFELINES is a research project funded by the Climb for Cancer Foundation designed to find ways to help Caregivers take good care of themselves. It is a joint project between the College of Public Health and Health Professions at the University of Florida and the University of Florida Shands Cancer Center Bone Marrow Transplant Unit.

The **CANCER SURVIVORSHIP PROGRAM** is one of the seven designated programs of partnership between the UF Shands Cancer Center and the Moffitt Cancer Center located in Tampa, Florida. The Climb for Cancer Foundation provided seed money to help establish this program which envisions the development of a model cancer survivorship program spanning the entire age continuum.

SPORTS AND SUMMER CAMPS give children with cancer the chance to play, to laugh, to be kids and to forget - for a moment - that they have cancer. The Climb for Cancer Foundation created the **Brandon Ling Memorial Sports Camp** at the University of Florida which is hosted by the University Athletic Association, Inc., and provides funding to **Camp Sunshine** in Georgia and **Camp Boggy Creek** in Florida so children with cancer have the opportunity to make new friends, learn new skills, be accepted as they are and have the fun all children should enjoy.

RESEARCH SEED MONEY is provided by the Foundation to sponsor cancer-related research, to allow researchers the opportunity to examine the psychosocial impacts cancer has on patients, their families and caregivers, and to encourage investigators to develop new ways to approach cancer-related issues.
